## Group #5 (Alicia): Focus on Adult Services

There were 7 consumers/providers, 1 family member, and 1 county staff in this group.

- 1. In looking at the key need and gap areas that have been identified so far, are there any, from your perspective, that are missing? If so, what are they?
  - More peer services, and compassion
  - System needs to be more friendly
  - Needs to be easier to access services
  - More collaboration and quick and effective referrals
  - Enhance information and availability
  - Disseminate information besides email & technology
  - Language thinks in layman terms so everyone can understand
  - Other agencies (such as law enforcement) need to be informed about mental health issues
  - Stigma, discrimination against homeless individuals, and persons with mental health issues
  - Jails, lawyers, judges, and probation all need more information & training (about mental health issues)
  - Staff need training about mental health needs (including about medications and behavior)
  - Work and education incentives for peers
  - Housing
  - More opportunities for peers, providers, and family members to communicate
  - Wellness education, life skills
  - No peer or family staff at the County
  - Speakers bureau ("shadow speakers")

## 2. Which need or gap areas are most important?

- Housing; this is fundamental
- Thorough "assessments" of person (mental health, substance use, educational level, financial, legal, etc). Note: some people find the word "assessment" offensive because it implies a "one down" relationship between the provider and the person seeking services.
- Re-integration into the community (having other places to go besides MHCAN)
- Stigma
- Mental wellness
- 3. Which need or gap areas should we focus on working on first?
  - Housing

- Wellness
- Instead of assessment... recognizing the person, communication, relationship.

## 4. Are there specific need or gap areas that may be unique or different for South County.

South County has a lot of potential. The gap is that there is not enough participation at Mariposa.

Also, there is a North and South County divide. There needs to be more interaction (between MHCAN and Mariposa, for example).
